The wards were handed over with vacant possession, but access & egress for operatives & materials had to be gained through the fully functional hospital.

The works consisted:

- Internal demolition & strip out of existing finishes, fixtures & fittings
- Extensive plaster repairs to existing walls
- Installation of new bespoke clinical wash basins & sluice facilities on purpose made IPS panels
- Repair / replace doors & frames as necessary
- Supply & install new HTM64 compliant worktops & units to amenity rooms & nurse stations
- Install new door & wall protection
- Installation of new vinyl / non slip vinyl flooring throughout.
- Dry lining of existing walls
- Complete decoration throughout.
- Reinstall all Client fixtures & fittings

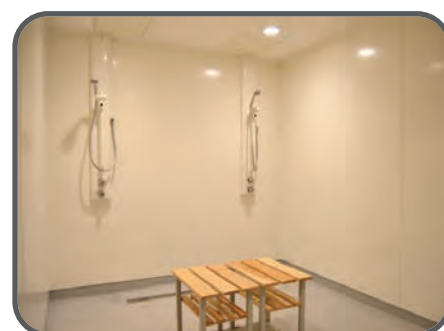

During the existing vinyl floor removal we came across a major problem, the sub floor was found to be breaking up and had to be completely replaced which delayed the contract by two weeks.

We installed a new Ventilation and heating system, new toilet and shower areas complete with Male and Female lockers, new lighting and flooring were installed and both areas were completely decorated.

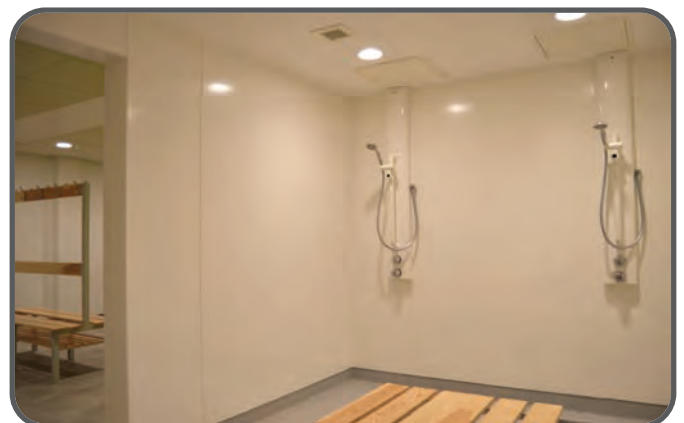
